Week 2: God

Younger Preschool

Theme Verse

“For everything was created by him, in heaven and on earth, the visible and the invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things have been created through him and for him” (Colossians 1:16).

Objective

God made me.

Teach

Visit a park, playground, zoo, farm, backyard, or anywhere outdoors for this lesson. Typically for younger preschoolers, their receptive language is stronger than their expressive language. The activity below is a language modeling exercise to help a 0–2-year-old begin learning foundational biblical truths.

F.A.R.M—Find, Ask, Respond, Mimic

Find

Look for an animal.

Ask

“(Child’s name), who made the (choose an animal)?”

Respond: “God made the (choose an animal)!”

Mimic: Imitate the sound and motions of the animal.

Continue F.A.R.M with other animals or to other things of creation (Examples: trees, Sun, water, fruit, etc.)

Discussion Questions

Review and repeat the question “(Child’s name), who made...?” and answer “God made...”

Play

Make the sound and motion of an animal. Encourage your child to copy you and then ask, “What animal is this?” Provide or help with the answer as necessary and then ask, “Who made that animal?”

Continue this week looking for opportunities to use the F.A.R.M exercise with your younger preschooler as an opportunity to regularly remind him or her that God made everything.

Closing Prayer

God, thank You for making everything. (Personalize this prayer by thanking God for your child’s favorite animals or anything else in creation).
