Week 5: Church

High School

Theme Verse

"Just as each one has received a gift, use it to serve others, as good stewards of the varied grace of God" (1 Peter 4:10).

Objective

The Church is not a place or building but is made up of the people who belong to the family of God. Under the Old Covenant, God dwelled in the temple or the tabernacle. Today, God dwells in His people and works through them to advance His kingdom.

Teach

Let's take a minute and read 1 Peter 4:10 together: "Just as each one has received a gift use it to serve others, as good stewards of the varied grace of God."

Everyone has a skill or talent God wants us to use for His Kingdom. In 1 Corinthians 12, Paul tells us the Lord has assigned each believer a unique set of spiritual gifts. Whether it's easy for you to send someone an encouraging note, serve your neighbor with a joyful heart, or explain things in a simple way, we can all use those skills to reflect the light of the Lord.

Although each person has a gift to share the love of God, some people have been specifically gifted by God to work in the church and teach or help others. The pastors and leaders at church have been trained to help others find and know their gift(s), so they can serve inside and outside of the church. They teach God's Word, so others can fully understand what it means and how to apply it to their daily lives. They help gather others with the gift of service to meet the needs of the people in the community—like at Bellevue Loves Memphis. Some have the gift of hospitality and can intentionally welcome and show

love to others in practical ways! Each week, we can see many in our church who use their gift to help grow and reach our Mission of Loving God, Loving People, Sharing Jesus, and Making Disciples with the Gospel.

Discussion Questions

- 1. Do you know what your spiritual gifts are? (Read 1 Corinthians 12.)
- 2. How do you use your gifts within the church? If you currently don't, what is stopping you? (Answers may vary.)

Play

Option 1:

Talk about your favorite sports team and the different positions on the team. Ask your student why the team needs different players with different skills. Compare this to the church and how we need different leaders with different gifts to help the many people in the church as well.

Option 2:

Grab a few pieces of paper and ask everyone to draw a stickman of their body. Ask them to label a few of the main parts of the body. Ask your student why the body needs different parts with different skills? Compare this to the Body of Christ—the Church. We need different leaders with different gifts to help the many people in the Church.
